

PROJECT UPDATE

Luddenham Advanced Resource Recovery Centre (ARRC)

April – May 2025



Project Overview:

The ARRC is designed to process up to 600,000 tonnes per annum of non-putrescible general solid waste, including building and demolition waste, as well as commercial and industrial waste. The facility aims to achieve a recovery rate of 85% from the processing of incoming materials.

The development has a capital investment value of \$20.4 million and is expected to generate 65 construction jobs and 178 operational jobs (70 direct and 108 indirect).

Our Work Schedule:

During the entire construction period, our standard work hours are **7am to 6pm**, Monday to Friday and **8am to 1pm**, Saturdays.

Unless otherwise notified, our night work construction hours are from 6pm to 5am, with no more than five consecutive nights of work at one time.

These hours exclude public holidays and inclement weather.

Works Underway:

Texco Construction has been selected to deliver the ARRC, with site establishment set to begin at the end of April 2024.

Early works will include minor vegetation clearing, fencing, and site establishment. The construction offices will be ready for the project team by mid-May 2025 and earth works will commence at the end of May 2025.

How Will Our Work Affect You?

During this phase of work, machinery and equipment, including large cranes, trucks, and light vehicles, will be used. As a result, some noise will be generated, and we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause.

Where possible, we will minimise noise by:

- Turning off machinery when not in use
- Positioning equipment, such as generators, away from properties and installing noise blankets
