

PROJECT UPDATE

Luddenham Advanced Resource Recovery Centre (ARRC)

June – July 2025



Project Overview:

The ARRC is designed to process up to 600,000 tonnes per annum of non-putrescible general solid waste, including building and demolition waste, as well as commercial and industrial waste. The facility aims to achieve a recovery rate of 85% from the processing of incoming materials.

The development is funded by private capital and is expected to generate 65 construction jobs and 178 operational jobs (70 direct and 108 indirect).

Upcoming work and milestones:

In June and July 2025, we will:

- Continue the ARRC building pad preparation and associated earthworks
- Commence concrete preparation work
- Retaining wall installation

What's happening now?

In June 2025, site earth works will continue for the ARRC project:

Work includes:

- Ongoing earthworks and ARRC building pad preparation
- Site access road improvements

How Will Our Work Affect You?
