

# PROJECT UPDATE

## Luddenham Advanced Resource Recovery Centre (ARRC)

December 2025



### Project Overview:

The ARRC is designed to process up to 600,000 tonnes per annum of non-putrescible general solid waste, including building and demolition waste, as well as commercial and industrial waste. The facility aims to achieve a recovery rate of 85% from the processing of incoming materials.

The development is fully funded by private capital and is expected to generate 65 construction jobs and 178 operational jobs (70 direct and 108 indirect).

### Upcoming work and milestones:

The project will now move into the next stages:

- Construction of the main building structures
- Installation of stormwater systems
- Adams Road upgrade, planned for early 2026
- Elizabeth Drive and Adams Road intersection upgrade, planned for early 2026

### What's happening now?

Earthworks at the ARRC project site are now complete, marking an important milestone. The project will now move into the next stages, which will bring visible progress across the area.

We will keep you updated as the project progresses.

### How Will Our Work Affect You?

You may notice an increase in worker and vehicle movements, as well as noise from machinery. We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

Some of the work may be noisy at times. To reduce the impact, we have implemented measures such as turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers on trucks.

Road upgrade works will require temporary road lines closures and changes to the current speed limits. More detailed information about these changes will be communicated to the community in advance.
