The complainant alleged that sediment was visible on the roadway on a recurring basis.	The complaint was recorded and investigated by CPG and Texco. The investigation included a review of inspection records, photographs, dust suppression and environmental monitoring reports, and a specialist assessment by Rubicon Enviro. Site inspections were undertaken, existing controls were reviewed, and additional precautionary measures were identified. The investigation did not substantiate the allegation of continuous or recurring sediment tracking from the Site.	Closed Investigation completed and response provided to EPA on 07/09/2026
